### International Baccalaureate (IB) Program

In the **North IBMYP Program** teaching and learning have a strong emphasis on international mindedness, interdisciplinary experiences, and higher order thinking skills. **All students** receive classes in the eight IBMYP subject areas - Math, Science, Individuals and Societies (*history and geography*), English, Physical Education, the Arts (*music, visual art and drama*), Technology and World Language Acquisition (*French, Spanish or Mandarin*) in addition to participation in the Service Learning Program.

The AVID Program is specifically directed towards those students who will be the first in their family to proceed to higher education classes.
