College Opportunity Fund (COF)

Complete the College Opportunity Fund (COF). The COF is a stipend that you may qualify for to reduce the cost of classes in most Colorado public and private schools.

FAFSA

Free Application for Financial Student Aid (FAFSA) is a way to borrow monies from the federal government to help pay for college and trade school programs. Whether you will use the FAFSA or not to pay for school, it is a good life skill in preparation for adulthood.

How to Complete:

*** FAFSA asks for detailed information from your family, including tax information. We respect that this information is personal, so there are several ways to complete this activity.

- Complete the FAFSA with your family
- Complete the FAFSA with a college/trade school program's Admissions office
- Complete the FAFSA at your high school's FAFSA Application Night(s) at your school
- Complete a paper-based version of the FAFSA that you do not submit, but it gives you practice into what FAFSA looks like without submitting personal family information.

1 College/ Trade School Application

Complete (1) or More College, Trade School, or Military Application Complete an application to a college, trade school, or the military as part of becoming Postsecondary & Workforce Ready (PWR).

How to Complete:

- Work with your school counselor to complete an application
- Complete an application with family and show completion to your school counselor

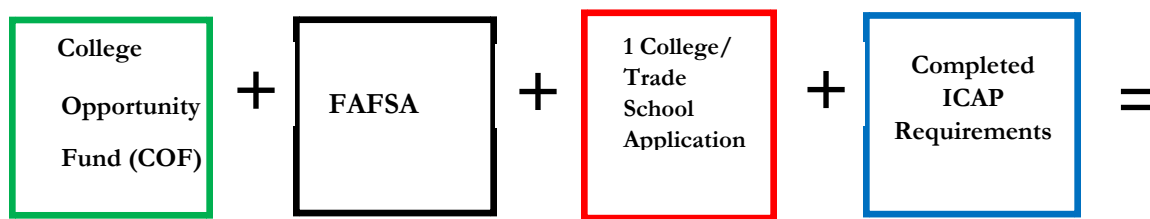
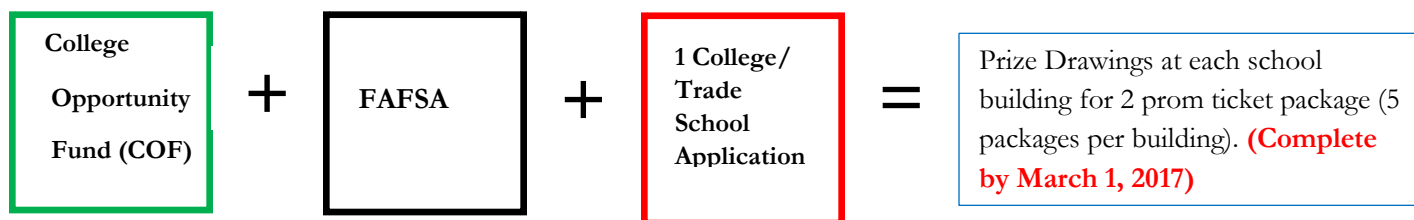
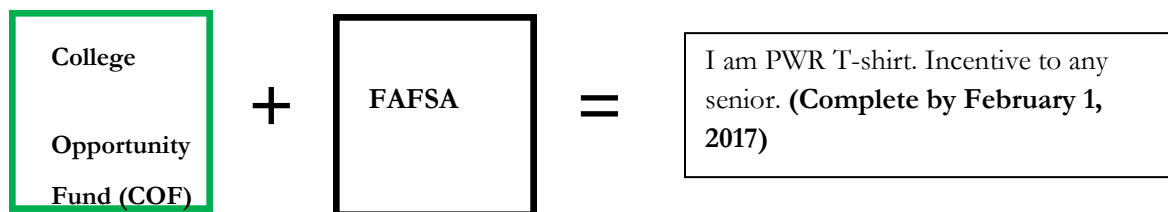
Complete ICAP Requirements Complete all requirements associated with the 2016-2017 Senior ICAP requirements.
